#### **SAFETY NEWS**

#### Do's and Don'ts for keeping cool on the road

This month I will go over 3 more things to stay cool on the road.

As I've mentioned before, I'm an ATGATT guy (All the Gear, All the Time). But as temperatures begin to creep up, even the most devoted safety gear wearer can find it challenging to balance safety and comfort.

Here are the final three (3) do's and don'ts to help you stay comfortable, cool, and safe on your motorcycle when the heat is on.

#### 1) DON'T Lose the Gloves

Think about falling off of your bike: What's the first thing that is going to hit the pavement? In all likelihood, it will be your hands. Hot weather gloves can be made from the same kind of high-tech materials and perforated leathers that we're finding in jackets nowadays. Just make sure that your gloves have sturdy, well protected palms for safety.

#### 2) DO use Cool Wraps

Keeping some cool moisture next to your skin can help keep your body temperature from rising. Several companies make cool wraps that encapsulate moisture-retaining crystals within cloth. Soak the cool wrap in water for a few minutes, and then use the wrap as a neckerchief during your ride. It will keep you cool for hours.

#### 3) DO Avoid the Midday Heat

Check the weather forecast before you ride. If it looks like a really hot day, consider heading out at dawn to take advantage of the cool morning air. Take a break from riding during the hottest part of the day- there's nothing like an afternoon nap under a shady tree to add to the vacation feeling. Then ride again in the early evening, when the heat abates.

DON'T be a victim of the heat.
